Fishkill Recreation Classic 2011

TOURNAMENT RULES & GAME STRUCTURE

(6th Grade Boys Division, 8th Grade Boys Division, & Girls Division)

1. Home team will be the first team listed on the schedule. (ex. 1v2 = Team 1 is Home team).
 - a. Home Team is responsible for the book, Guest Team is responsible for the clock
 - b. Score Book will be available.
2. 20 Minute Halves running time.
 - a. Stopped clock for the last 2 minutes of each half
3. 3 Full time outs per team
4. One and One will be on the 7th Team Foul per half
5. Double Bonus on the 10th Team Foul per half
6. After a player's 5th foul, he is "fouled out" and must be substituted out for the remainder of the game.
 - a. If the team needs him in the game to make up 5 players, he may stay in the game, but every foul committed by that player will result in an automatic 2 Shot penalty and loss of possession.
7. If there is a tie after regulation, there will be 2 minute overtimes until a winner is determined
 - a. An additional time out will be rewarded for each overtime period.
8. Full Court Press will be allowed at any point in the game with the exception of the following
 - a. If a team is up by 15 points or more, the leading team must be call the press off.
 - b. The team losing by 15 points or more is still allowed to press.
9. Ball Size:
 - a. Boys Divisions will use an official size (29.5) Men's Ball.
 - b. Girls Division will use an official size (28.5) Women's Ball.
10. If a team is winning by 30 points or more, we will not display the remaining scores on the scoreboard in attempt to avoid a drop in moral by the losing team. We will still keep the record of the score in the book in the event that the game gets within 20 "real" points.
11. Each Division may have a separate tournament layout as far as schedules go depending on number of teams participating.
 - a. If there is a tie, the winner will be determined by the head to head matchup.
 - b. If there is still a tie, the tie break will be determined by the point system (max 15 per game).
 - c. If a tie is still in place, the winner will be determined by coin toss or name out of a hat method.
12. There will be no tolerance for unsportsmanlike conduct.
 - a. Referees may issue a technical foul for anything they deem unsportsmanlike conduct.
 - b. If a player receives a 2nd technical foul, he is automatically ejected from the game.
 - c. If this leaves a team with less than 5 players they must play the remainder of the game with the remaining players.
 - d. Excessive language may be considered unsportsmanlike conduct.
 - e. Tournament Directors and referees reserve the right to ask a team, coach, player, or spectator to leave the facility.
8. 10 minutes after the scheduled start of the game shall be considered a forfeit.
 - a. On the agreement of both coaches, players from the team that has enough players may be split up to make even teams and a game may be played, but will still count as a loss for the team without enough players.
 - b. **At no time may a non-registered player participate.**
 - c. Games may be played with only 4 players without resulting in forfeit but under the agreement of both Coaches and Officials.
 - d. Less than 4 players is an automatic forfeit.

**In an effort to keep our gym neat and clean, there is NO FOOD or DRINK allowed inside the gymnasium.

Water Bottles will be for sale throughout the tournament.**
