**NO** trucks such as U-Hauls, vans, utility trailers larger than the bed of a pick-up truck will be permitted into Maurer/Geering Park to dump their bulk debris. **ONLY** ordinary pickup trucks will be allowed.

Cleanup items must be separated by wood, metals, and soft miscellaneous trash. **Construction debris will not be accepted.**

The following items cannot be accepted due to landfill restriction: Engine oil, lawn and garden chemicals (such as fertilizer), insecticides, pesticides, poisons, brush, leaves, drain cleaning chemicals and other cleaning and caustic solvents, paint materials (such as latex or oil based paints, turpentine, shellacs, sealers, mineral spirits and other paint related materials), gasoline, kerosene, and other flammable liquids (including containers that were used for these products) aerosol cans and other pressurized tanks.

Tires will NO longer be accepted at clean-up days. You may bring them to Royal Carting for a fee.
