Covid-19 Procedures and Policies July 8 2020

At Fishkill Recreation, safety is and has always been our # 1 priority. Our goal is to develop an exciting program full of fun activities and themes while keeping all of our campers and staff safe and healthy.

The following is our action plan in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Please read and sign acknowledgement of this action plan.

Health Screening:

- We are asking that you self-screen your child for about 5-7 days prior to camp. Observe your child and check for any [signs and symptoms of COVID-19](#) and notify us if there is anything worthy of noting.
- Staff and campers must stay home if you are sick, not feeling well, or exhibiting any [signs and symptoms of COVID-19](#). The person picking up and dropping off should also be healthy.
- All campers and staff must consent to having their temperature taken by a non-invasive scanner each morning upon arrival and then again after lunch. If a reading of 100.4 or greater is present, the individual must go home and can not attend camp until they have been 72 hours fever free without any additional signs and symptoms of the COVID-19 as out outlined by the CDC guidelines for ["When can I be around others?"](#)
- If a staff or camper becomes ill while at camp, they will be isolated with our Health Director until they can be picked up. All parents should have a backup plan in the event that they are unable to pickup their child while camp is in session.
- We will follow guidance from the Department of Health if a staff member or camper gets ill.
- Your child should not attend camp if they have visited an area prevalent with the COVID-19 within 14 days prior to the first day of camp.

Masks:

- Everyone (staff, campers, & parents) must wear a mask during sign in & sign out.
- Campers will not be required to wear a mask all day but need to have a mask with them throughout the day for situations when social distancing can't be practiced or it is deemed necessary to put one on.
- Staff will wear masks whenever they are unable to practice social distancing.
- Masks must be worn by everyone while using the restrooms.
- Although not our recommendation, if a parent requests that their child wear a mask all day then we will do our best to enforce that.
- Please use your best parental judgment on sending your child to camp if he/she falls within the vulnerable populations (asthma, compromised immune systems, etc).

Capacity:

- We are operating at approximately 50% capacity from the previous season.

Groups:

- Campers will be broken into groups of no more than 10.
- Groups will remain the same all summer. (This is not really new. We have always separated groups by grade/gender.)
- Groups will not intermingle with each other regularly.
- Masks will be worn when groups need to intermingle or be within six feet from each other.

Handwashing Hygiene:

- We have a set of bathrooms on site at Geering Park.
- We also rented two handwashing stations that will be positioned onsite so that frequent handwashing can be easily accessible.
- Counselors will urge campers to wash hands frequently especially after they may have shared an item (markers, balls, etc), sneezed, coughed, were in close proximity with other groups, etc.

Cleaning & Disinfecting:

- All playgrounds, picnic tables, restrooms, sporting equipment, frequently touched surfaces, etc will be disinfected regularly throughout each day.
