Covid-19 Procedures and Policies June 25, 2021

At Fishkill Recreation, safety is and has always been our # 1 priority. Our goal is to develop an exciting program full of fun activities and themes while keeping all of our campers and staff safe and healthy.

In collaboration with our local health department, the following is action plan in response to COVID-19. Please note that this plan is subject to change as new guidance or situations may develop.

Health Screening:

- Staff and campers must stay home if you are sick, not feeling well, or presenting a fever.
- All campers and staff must consent to having their temperature taken by a non-invasive scanner each morning upon arrival.
- Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or greater must go home and can not attend camp until they have been 24 hours fever free without the use of fever reducing medication.
- If a staff or camper becomes ill while at camp, they will be removed from their group until they can be picked up or sent home. All parents should have a backup plan in the event that they are unable to pickup their child while camp is in session.

Groups:

- Campers will be broken into groups of no more than 12 based on grade and gender. *(This is not really new. We have always separated groups by grade/gender.)*
- Although groups may intermingle from time to time, it will be limited in an effort to prevent any possible spread of disease across multiple groups of campers/staff.

Masks/Facial Coverings:

- Masks/facial coverings are optional for campers. Campers are not required to wear a mask but if you prefer your child to wear one we will ensure that your child keeps one on. *(Please note that although masks are optional for campers, NYS and CDC recommends that all unvaccinated persons wear a mask. If you chose to allow your child to remove his/her mask, you are doing so at your own risk.)*
- Masks/facial coverings are optional for staff who has presented proof of vaccination to our HR Department Staff. Vaccinated staff may decide to wear a mask if they choose to do so.
- Staff who has not been vaccinated against COVID-19 will be required to wear a mask whenever social distancing is not possible.
- We encourage campers to wear a mask during sign in & sign out but it is not mandatory.
- We encourage unvaccinated adults to wear a mask at all times as recommended by the CDC but is not mandatory.
- As always. . . Please use your best parental judgment on sending your child to camp if he/she falls within the vulnerable populations (asthma, compromised immune systems, etc).

Handwashing Hygiene:

- We have a set of restrooms on site at Geering Park with sinks.
- We also rented two handwashing stations that will be positioned onsite so that frequent handwashing can be easily accessible.
- Counselors will urge campers to wash hands frequently throughout the day.

Cleaning & Disinfecting:

- Sporting and gaming equipment will be cleaned/disinfected daily.
